#### City of Pocatello (Merril Quayle):

- Reported working on the following projects
  - Carson Street Bridge Project will be open by end of July. Paving tomorrow.
  - Hawthorne/Quinn Intersection in Phase II. Will open in 2 to 3 weeks, then close again in March 2024 for signal installation.
  - Child Safety Hawthorne and Jensen in design. (Possible from Robin to Eldredge, as money is available.)
  - Main Street Pedestrian Bulb Out Fremont to Day.
  - S Main and S Arthur and Bannock Hwy design intersection improvements.
  - Monte Vista pathway from Monte Vista to Pocatello Creek is in design.

#### Street Department (Mike)

- South Valley Road and Bannock Hwy signal design. Hope to complete by next summer 2024.
- Micro Sealing in August (2-3 weeks)
- Mike discussed paving no cutting roads within three years after paving unless it's an emergency.

#### Water Department

- Pocatello Creek Booster Station
- 5MG tank transmission line cross Grant Fore Road continuing.
- Starting 2023 projects, on Buchanan now.

#### o WPC

- Whitman Lift Station construction wrapping up.
- WPC Phase I, work on upgrades at plant.
- Indian Hills Lift Station upgrades in design.

#### 9. Any other items from the council

- Discussion: patching standards in cities outside of Pocatello. Phil indicated that most cities require a 2' overcut. For those that don't, IMG continues doing the 2' overcut.
- Merril asked that if your company has a 2–3-year plan, submit it so the City can work paving around that when possible.
