*Open Discussion –

Irrigation Districts: Several participants voiced concerns with the process of getting canal permits, very lengthy for some with little communication. Will work on gathering contact information and see about getting these irrigation districts to attend UCC meeting for discussion on process and best practices.

County responsible box to box (in the right away), ACHD to look into the question as to whether you still need to go thru the Irrigation Dist in those cases or if you can go direct to county.

Tri County UCC: Voted to dissolve due to lack of participation/attendance. Julie suggested reaching out to those members to see if they would be interested in joining Ada or Canyon County UCC in place of. Stephanie to reach out.

City of Meridian to provide their project preview at the April meeting for discussion.

ADA Advisory Group: Traffic Control required audible voice direction devices “squawk boxes” in 2026. Concerns on the economic impact this will have on contractors to complete jobs. A representative from ACHD will talk on this subject at the April meeting.
