2. Approval of Minutes from the March 9th meeting

Council was asked to approve the minutes from the March 9th meeting as written. Motion to approve made by Doug Brooks and seconded by Russell Christ. Motion passed.

3. Financial Report

As of the end of March, the Bannock UCC has a balance of \$2,140.16.

5. <u>Digline Information and News</u>

- Ticket information can be found online at https://www.digline.com/statistics.
- Ticket volume only increased 1% in Bannock County from 2020 to 2021 (an additional 96 tickets). There was an 11% increase statewide.
- When COVID hit, construction did not slow down. In 2019, there were 1,084 homeowner tickets. In 2020, there were 1,346 homeowner tickets. A 25% increase! In 2021, there was a 16% decrease. This tells us that the homeowner is being reached and awareness tools are working. (Billboards, TV ads, etc.)
- FYI: Summit is no longer working with Century Link. Stake Center, out of Utah, has taken over that.

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Positive Response Positive Response (STATUS PORTAL) LOGIN

Positive Response is the communication link between the Requester and the Utility Owner/Locator. It is a means for the Utility Owner/Locator to inform the Requester about the status of a locate request. For questions regarding the status of a locate request refer to the Positive Response Status Portal or contact the Utility Owner directly.

Participation in Digline's Positive Response service is not mandatory. Utility Owners may already provide Positive Response via an alternate method or may not provide a Positive Response service at all. Review your locate request status to determine which Utility Owners utilize Digline's Positive Response service.

Digline agents do not have access to Positive Response information. For all Positive Response inquiries refer to this site or contact the Utility Owner directly







- The current Portal is configured for Positive Response only. This will allow users to check the status of their tickets and contact locators if their marks are incomplete or not present.
- We are in the process of developing the Contractor phase of the Portal. This will allow Homeowners, Members and Contractors to submit their locate requests using their own sketches on a Google Maps background.

Digline Locate Policy (Contractor Phase)

- The site you have described and drawn will be the only area located on this request. The utilities listed on the confirmation ticket are the only underground facilities that will be notified. You must notify any other known underground facility owners in the area. Private utility lines such as sprinklers, water or sewer lines on private property and power or gas lines beyond the meter will not be marked by the public utilities. Information on private utilities and locators is at: http://www.digline.com/homeowners/private-lines-public/.
- You are not clear to begin excavation until all known facilities have been marked and the two business days has passed. Once marked, Idaho Code requires you to hand dig with a shovel or soft-dig with air or water pressure within 24 inches on either side of the marked facilities. The depth of underground lines is not guaranteed. Your locate request is valid for 21 days, starting tomorrow, as long as site conditions have not changed.

Things to Consider

- Positive Response is not mandated by Idaho Statute
- ➤ If an account has already been created in association with your Contractor ID or Member Code you will need to contact Digline Administration to create additional login credentials for the same account
 - > We recommend using a group email for account creations to avoid this situation
- ➤ If you require access to multiple Contractor IDs and/or Member Codes you will need to contact Digline Administration for the account associations
- Contractor Ticket Search period is 14 days
- ➤ Member Ticket Search period is 30 days

What is an Update Ticket?

Update Ticket

➤ A locate request submitted to change or add pertinent excavation information or to extend the validity of an existing locate request.

Possible Reasons for an Update

- Valid current ticket is about to expire.
- > Dig info has changed or has been expanded.
- > There is a loss of marks due to active excavation or weather.

Ticket Handling

> Treated as a new Standard ticket: Locators have 2 business days to mark.
