- Subdivisions underway – Fairway estates, Brookside, and a handful of other subdivisions they're getting bids back on and will be underway shortly.
- Heard out at Comore Loma they were digging a well the other day and about 780' they hit water and it was 105°.

Falls Water

- Lincoln road project – Moving meters back and have only had a few problems or push back from residences when moving water lines.
- Had a group approach them about wanting to get a waterline down St. Leon out by the junk yards.

- Falls water is up for sale – A couple of different companies are looking at buying it. Sale would take place in the next couple of months depending on the P.U.C.

Syringa Networks

- Lincoln road project – Biggest concern is getting our fiber changes done before they fill the canal
- Talked about what projects we've noticed downtown (Park and Capital)
- Few jobs going on in Pocatello, but nothing really going on other than the Lincoln project.
