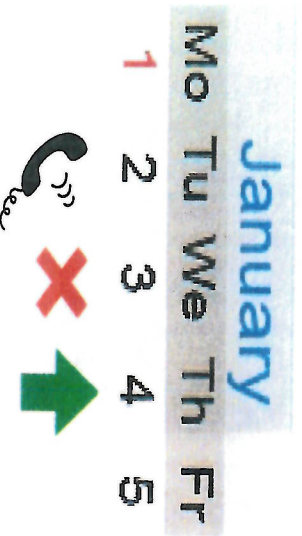

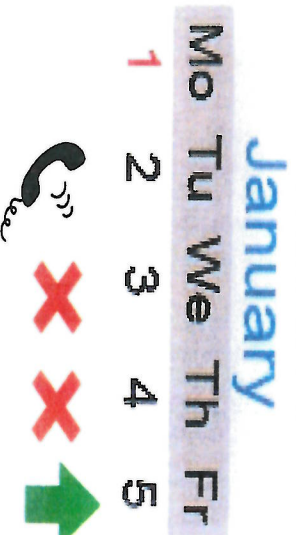

§ 73-109. Computation of Time

The time in which any act provided by law is to be done is computed by excluding the first day, and including the last unless the last is a holiday and then it is also excluded.

§ 55-2205. Permit Compliance – Notice of Excavation – Response to Notice

The owner of the underground facility or the owner's agent providing the information shall respond no later than two (2) business days after the receipt of the notice.

"**Business day**" means any 24-hour day other than a Saturday, Sunday or federal or **state** legal holiday.
