#### Damage Prevention (Bill Hale)

○ Treasure Valley Stand Down Day – June 23<sup>rd</sup> from 7 a.m. – 1 p.m. Focus is on safety and there will be four 30-minute classes where people will rotate tent to tent.

- Carson Street Bridge Project construction continuing; done by end of June

- Child Safety Hawthorne and Jensen in design. (Possible from Robin to Eldredge, as money is available.)
- Main Street Pedestrian Bulb Out Fremont to Day. Keller is working on this.
- S Main and S Arthur and Bannock Hwy design intersection improvements. Planning for August.

#### Water Department

- Patching and disinfection Transmission line and Booster Station
- Currently working on Buchanan
- Transmission line Arthur to Fore Road.
